Funded Student Technology Fee Proposals for 2003-2004 Fiscal Year

Along with its responsibilities for strategic technology planning, STPIG has served as a preliminary body that reviews all proposals for the expenditure of the money collected through the Student Technology Fee. This year a subcommittee of STPIG called the Student Technology Fee (STF) Committee was formed to evaluate the proposals. This year STF considered 52 proposals. Members of the STF Committee are:

The recommendations of the STF were endorsed by STPIG as a whole and sent to the Provost who made the final decisions (with

additional input) on the awarding of funds.

As with last year, a goal for this year's recommendations was to limit the percentage of funds expended for recurring costs (e.g., labor, maintenance agreements, software licensing, etc.). STPIG believes that recurring costs should not exceed 35% - 40% of the total revenue available. Previous funding has obligated recurring costs that are close to this amount and the STPIG sub-group considering this year's proposals did not recommend projects which would add significantly to recurring costs.
